

RESEARCH PRESENTATIONS FOR THE ADAPTIVE SPORTS USA 2019 CONFERENCE

The Adaptive Sport USA 2019 National Conference scheduled for November 10-12th in Phoenix, AZ is proud to include a Research poster session and panel discussion.

There will be two formats for Research Presentations: Posters and Podium (free communication). Professionals and Emerging Scholars are welcome.

Guidelines for Poster Presentations by Professionals:

- Proposal abstract length: 150-200 words
- Posters should present current, original research, or most current research related issues such as advocacy, professional development, training, or other areas.
- Poster presentation proposals should include the following sections and/or headers: Title; Authors, Affiliation, Contact information; Introduction/Purpose; Methodology; Results/Discussion; Summary/Conclusions.
- The poster should be no larger than 3' x 4' in size. Adaptive Sports USA will provide poster putty for mounting. Poster Presentation authors should plan to bring handouts of poster material such as the reference list and the poster content, a one page abstract with author contact information, business cards, etc., to give to those interested. Announcement of the Research presentations will be made available on the Adaptive Sport USA National Conference web page.

Guidelines for Free Communications Presentations (Podium) by Professionals:

- Proposal abstract length: 150-200 words
- Free communications should be centered on research, best practices, advocacy, grant seeking, or other areas associated with adaptive sports. The free communications should be formatted as a 15-18 minute oral presentation that will be presented to the audience of attendees and allowing 3-5 min for audience discussion.

Guidelines for Posters from Emerging Scholars Symposium (Graduate Students – Masters and/or PhD) will follow the same guidelines mentioned above.

Submission guidelines

The deadline for submission of abstracts to participate in the Research Track - **Friday June 21, 2019. Submit all abstracts to Rdavis4@twu.edu.**

Abstracts will be processed within 1-2 weeks of receipt for acceptance to the Research Track and session assignments will be made by August 1, 2019.
